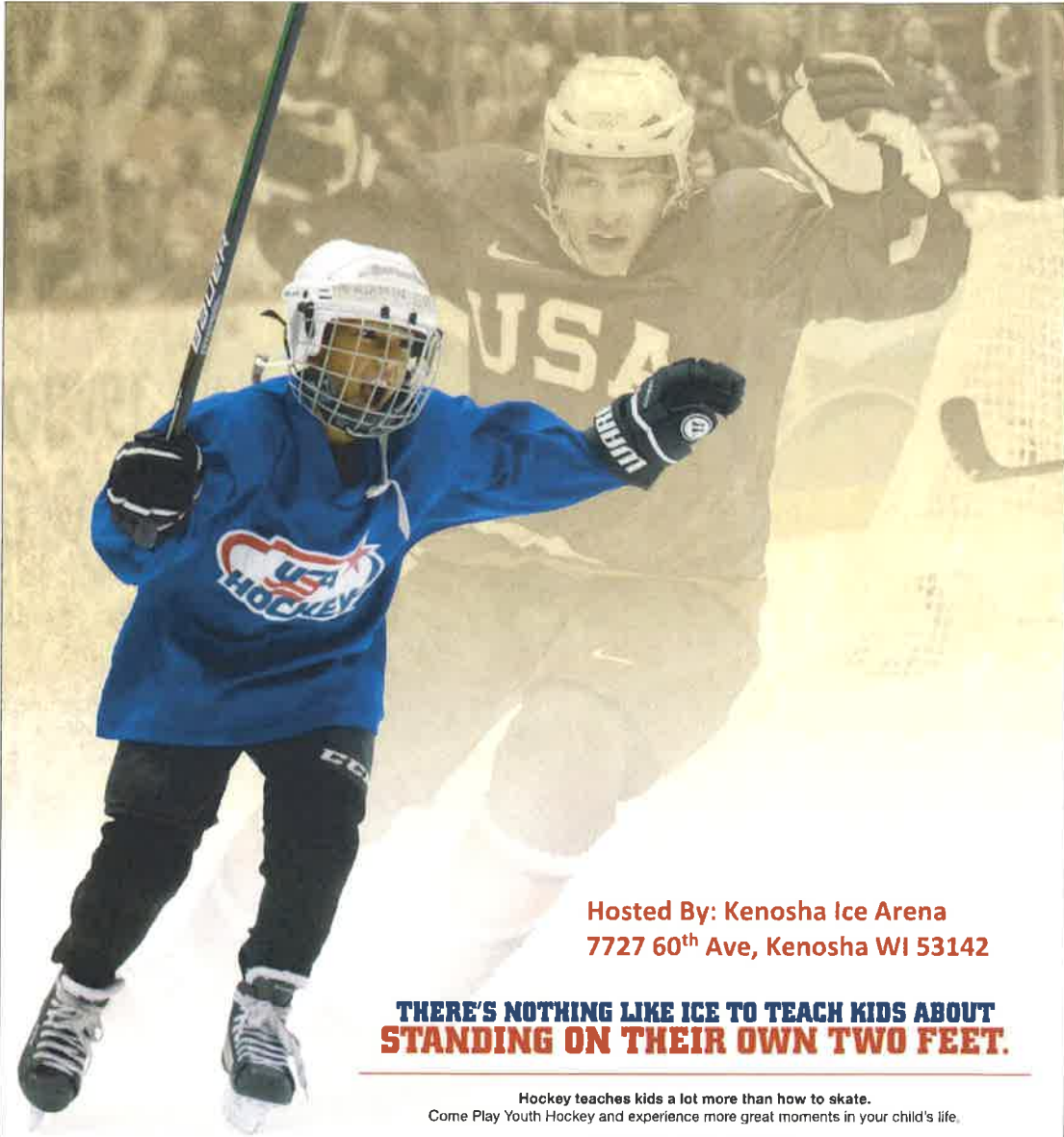

To the parents of the Winthrop Harbor School District #1,

The Police Department has received a plethora of complaints regarding driving and parking around Westfield School and North Prairie Jr. High School. To assist in keeping the students safe and to alleviating some issues, we would like to remind drivers of the following;

- **Westfield School**

- Holdridge Avenue
  - No parking on the West side between Ja-lor Court and 9<sup>th</sup> Street.
  - No parking, standing, or stopping on the East side of the street at any time
- Russell Avenue
  - No parking on the South/West corner, from the posted sign to the corner of 9<sup>th</sup> Street.
  - Parking *is* allowed on the West side from 8<sup>th</sup> Street South to the posted sign during School hours.
  - No parking, standing, or stopping on the East side of the street at any time
- Ellis Avenue
  - No parking on North/West corner, 9<sup>th</sup> Street to posted sign.
  - No parking, standing, or stopping on the East side of the street at any time
- 9<sup>th</sup> Street
  - No parking, stopping, or standing is permitted along 9<sup>th</sup> Street. Please do not use 9<sup>th</sup> Street as a loading/unloading zone for your students.
  - For safety of all pedestrians, please use crosswalk located at 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Russell Avenue.



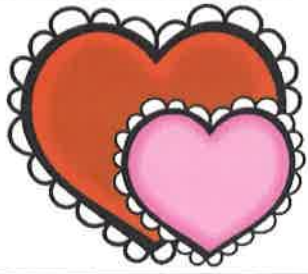

- **North Prairie Jr. High School**
  - 6<sup>th</sup> Street North side – Between North Avenue and Cavin Avenue.
    - No parking, standing, or stopping on the North side of the Street on School days between the hours posted.
  - 6<sup>th</sup> Street South side.
    - No parking, standing, or stopping on the South side of the street at any time.
  - North Avenue West side– Between 5<sup>th</sup> Street and 7<sup>th</sup> Street.
    - No parking, standing, or stopping on the North side of the Street on School days between the hours posted.
  - North Avenue East side.
    - No parking, standing, or stopping on the East side of the street at anytime.
- Available parking for student pick-up;
  - North Prairie Parking lot.
  - North side of 5<sup>th</sup> Street between North Avenue and Robert’s Road
  - North parking lot of Village park at 7<sup>th</sup> Street and North Avenue.
